

## CREDENTIAL PROGRAMS - CALIFORNIA STATE SCHOOLS

Below is a sampling of CSU credential programs offering **traditional single subject credentials** and **intern programs** (working towards a credential while teaching with a paid salary). There are additional requirements for each program that are not listed here, please see individual school websites for more details.

**Note:** For CSU's, you need to apply BOTH to the graduate school (via "CSU Mentor") AND the credential program. CSU application fee: \$55/school. \*\*Also, \$ amounts are estimates.\*\*
