Testing requirements	CBEST, CSET, and <b>GRE</b> (General) <b>Note:</b> A subject matter program replaces the CSET requirement. Register for CSET no later than March 2014 test date. Must take CBEST and GRE by application date.
Minimum GPA	“outstanding academic preparation”
Cost (2012-13)	Tuition: \$32,730/year + \$8,940 for summer

Testing requirements	CBEST and CSET--passing scores by August (enrollment)
Minimum GPA	Entire application is considered not just the GPA.
Cost	Tuition: \$29,860/year with fees \$30,994
