

Cal Teach TB Testing Procedure

Before you can be placed in a local school, you **must** document your TB status. If you have tested for TB within the past 4 years, please submit the medical report to the Cal Teach Office. Otherwise, you will need to be tested.

If you have UC SHIP (UC Student Health Insurance Plan):

1. Call (831) 459-2500 to schedule the 15 minute appointment for one of the Cal Teach Clinic Days (11/29 2-4:30pm or 12/2 8:30-11:30am). **Let the Student Health Center know that you are part of the Cal Teach Clinic Days**
2. On your appointment date, go to the Health Center to have your test, we will be charged if you do not show.
3. Return 48-72 hours later to have your test read.
4. Submit proof of your negative TB status to Cal Teach. If you test positive, Cal Teach will pay for the follow-up exam.

If you have other health insurance:

1. (a) Make an appointment with a private doctor .
OR
(b) Go to [Doctor's on Duty](#) (walk-in services, \$30, Cal Teach will reimburse upon submission of receipt).
2. Return 48-72 hours later to have your test read.
3. Submit proof of your negative TB status to Cal Teach. If you test positive, Cal Teach will pay for the follow-up exam.
