Testing requirements	CBEST, CSET, U.S Constitution Requirement, Fundamental Mathematics Course (Multiple Subject Applicants), Bilingual Test Requirement (BCLAD Applicants)
Minimum GPA	3.0+ If lower, may reevaluate based on last two years or upper-div coursework. If still below 3.0, can submit 3 letters of rec. ONLY those below 3.0 need submit letters.

Duration	5 Quarters (15 months) including fall, winter, spring, and then fall winter of teaching full time and finishing courses for the M.A.

Type of credentials offered	M.A.T. w/ Teacher Credential (15 months, 5 quarters) Single Subject credential w/o MAT (3 quarters, FWS) Intern teacher credential (start spring and summer, then teach fall) M.S. in Chemistry w/ Teacher Credential (2 years)+can TA-\$16,200! M.S. in Math w/ Teacher Credential (2-3 years) **for M.S., must apply to chem or math grad school also**
Testing requirements	CBEST (taken before applying, passed before program starts) CSET (passed before applying, but for science and math, may be accepted conditionally) GRE for MAT program only
Minimum GPA	3.0 in all coursework completed in the junior and senior years
Cost (2013-14)	Tuition + Fees: \$15,553.50/year
