**Khine Thwin** is a third year chemistry major originally from Daly City who transferred to UCSC from Skyline College in fall 2009.

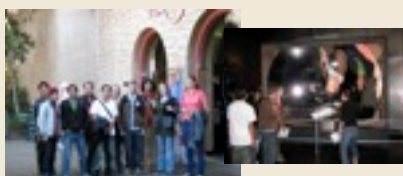
She is in her first Cal Teach internship at New Brighton Middle School with host teacher Molly Deich.
