When you accept a student loan, you accept legal and financial responsibilities that last until the loan is repaid. When you sign this document, you acknowledge that you understand your rights and responsibilities and agree to abide by them. After reading each statement, place a check in the box provided.

- 1. I received a student loan and must repay my loan as called for in the promissory note, which was mutually agreed upon by my lender and me. I must repay my loan, including interest and fees, whether or not I complete my education, obtain employment, or am satisfied with my education.
- 2. I must inform all of my lenders or billing servicers immediately of any change in my name, address, or social security number.
- 3. Provisions of my promissory note may require payment of my loans in minimum monthly or quarterly installments.
- 4. I may accelerate payment, make payment prior to the due date, or make payment in excess of the amount due without penalty. This can reduce the total amount of interest I will be required to pay over the life of my loans, but unless designated, will not automatically apply to my next scheduled payment.
- 5. I may be eligible to defer, postpone and/or cancel repayment of my loans. The appropriate forms to request any one of these entitlements can be obtained from my lenders or billing servicers. I must file all paperwork required for these privileges (with all required certifications) in a timely manner with my lender or lenders. I understand that failure to do so may have a negative effect on my credit record. I am responsible for renewing my entitlements.
- 6. If I cannot make a payment on time for any reason and/or I wish to request forbearance, I must contact my lenders prior to the due date.
- 7. My loans may be subject to late charges if payments are past due depending on the provisions of my promissory note.
- 8. I may be required to pay the total cost of collection and/or litigation if my loans become past due and remain past due without appropriate arrangements to bring them current.
- 9. If I fail to repay my student loans I will be considered in *DEFAULT* and the following could result:
 - My delinquency will be reported to a national credit bureau and will have a negative and long-term effect on my credit rating.
 - The entire unpaid amount of my loans, including interest, may become immediately due and payable.
 - My federal and state income tax refunds may be withheld and my wages may be garnished.
 - I will be ineligible to receive any additional federal or state financial aid funds (PELL, SEOG, CWS, Perkins Loan, FFEL, PLUS, William D. Ford Direct Loan) at any institution.
 - The University may withhold all services including future enrollments and official academic transcripts.
 - My default will have an effect on the future of these loan programs and could jeopardize the educational opportunities of future students.
 - I will have a lot of people angry with me, a lot of hassle, and will still have to pay back my loan. It is not worth it!
